The VdTMoCA Foundation (UK) has updated its Privacy Policy which reflects the changes introduced by the new European data protection law known as the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), which goes into effect on 1st May 2018.

By accessing or using our Services, you agree to this Privacy Policy.

How do we obtain your personal information?

When you register to become a member of the VdTMoCA Foundation (UK) you provide us with personal information including, your name, address, telephone number, e-mail, and the healthcare provider you work for.

Where do we store your information?

Your information is stored within a database only accessible by Foundation Directors.

How do we use your information?

- To process and administer your membership
- To send regular updates and information, advertisements for training events and newsletters.
- To carry out market research so that we can improve the services we offer
- To monitor the growth of membership and geographical location.

Do we share your information?

We share your contact name and email address with the International Creative Ability Network (ICAN) for the purpose of creating a joint email list through which to send you information of interest.

We do not share your information with any other company or organisation outside the VdTMoCA Foundation (UK) unless we have your consent to do so.
